Inclusive Education

We take pride in bridging gaps in class, social, and economic divisions. Our students learn side by side with local children whose families can afford their own school fees. Over the past decade, our school has grown remarkably, evolving from its 'pioneer' class in 2009 to serving a population of over 500 students today.



Diverse Student Body

Our student body ranges from three-year-old preschoolers to eighth graders, with over 33% benefiting from full scholarships, and another 7% on partial scholarships.

At high school under the Scholars' program, there are 61 students in various High Schools around the country and 30 who have joined tertiary colleges; and pursuing prestigious programs like aeronautical engineering, medicine, law, and computer science. A significant number have enrolled in middle level colleges to acquire artisan skills that plugs into the Kenyan job market.



Holistic Education

In addition to academics, NMS offers a vibrant array of co-curricular activities, including a Drama club, Football Club, Rotaract Club, Music program, and French Club. These activities ensure a well-rounded education for our students, fostering their personal growth and development.

Nambale Magnet School has set a strong benchmark as we transition into the new Competency-Based Curriculum (CBC) introduced by the Kenyan Government. The CBC places emphasis on practical and hands-on learning.


We take immense pride in our last batch of students, who have not only excelled in the traditional academic system but also paved the way for success in the evolving educational landscape of Kenya.
