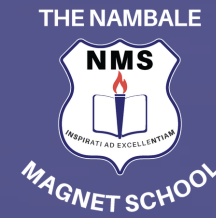

2002

Returns home from Yale.

Evalyn comes back to a Nambale community reshaped by *HIV/AIDS and extreme poverty* —hundreds of children orphaned, with nowhere to turn.

2004

Founds WIKS.

With a group of professional women, she starts Women’s Initiative for Knowledge and Survival to support women and children through education.

2009

Opens The Nambale Magnet School.

Not simply to *educate children*, but to *break the cycle of poverty* by building a place where vulnerable and fee-paying learners grow together.

2011

Earns global recognition.

Evalyn receives Yale Divinity School’s *Lux et Veritas Award* for applying the compassion of Christ to human need.

A model that works.

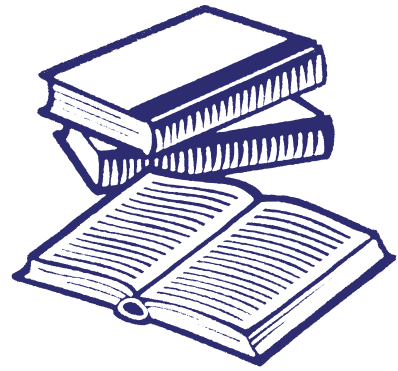

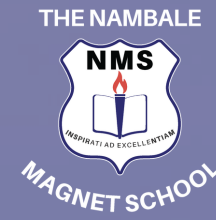

NMS has demonstrated a sustainable model with proven educational and community outcomes.

The Nambale Magnet School has moved beyond proof of concept.

For **17 years**, it has demonstrated that an inclusive, financially resilient model can deliver outstanding educational outcomes for vulnerable children while strengthening the wider community.



Inclusion by design

Orphaned and vulnerable children learn alongside fee-paying peers in one integrated school community, creating dignity, belonging, and shared opportunity rather than dependence.



Built to sustain itself

A 10-acre farm, dairy, poultry, and Black Soldier Fly enterprise reduce operating costs, improve nutrition, and generate income—demonstrating how education and enterprise can reinforce one another.



A track record that compounds

300+ graduates, a 100% transition rate to secondary school, and alumni progressing to universities and technical colleges demonstrate consistent long-term outcomes.

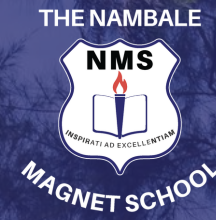

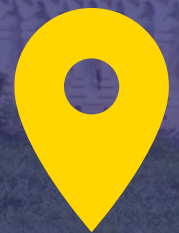

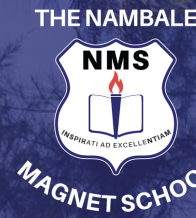
